



So Much More than Clothing Drops and Thrift Stores

Most people know about our clothing drops and thrift stores, but that's just the tip of the iceberg when it comes to the ministry of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul. Our volunteers spend precious hours visiting, supporting and otherwise working to meet the needs of neighbors we serve.

The core of our mission is the home visit, during which we listen and learn to understand the needs at hand. We offer spiritual, morale and financial support to those who are facing hard times. Any and all neighbors in need are welcome to our aid, regardless of faith or status.



In the last year, within the local conference and in collaboration with Parish Social Ministries of Our Lady Queen of Martyrs and Saint Philip Neri, volunteers have made 15 home visits and spent hundreds of hours meeting, phoning, and following up on details to support 73 people in 12 families. During the year our conference has disbursed over \$22,000 to help neighbors pay for rent, utilities, food, furniture and other expenses.
