Workbook study and discussion

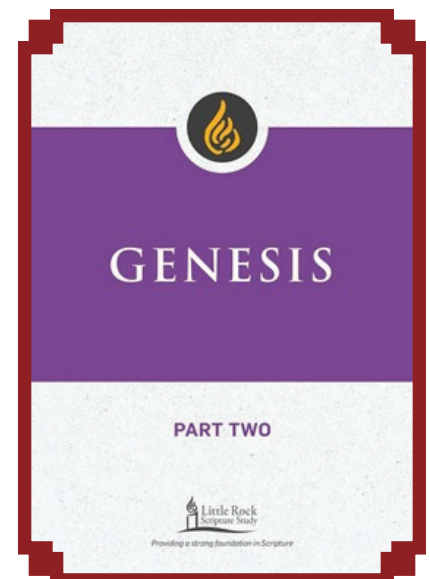
